The university offers a variety of housing options to meet the diverse needs of undergraduate and graduate students living on the Fairfax and SciTech campuses. Undergraduate students may choose from suites and apartments with most of our first-year population living in traditional style housing. Room rates are subject to approval on an annual basis by the Board of Visitors. Rates for the 2025-2026 academic year should be available on or before May 1. All students who complete housing application must provide a nonrefundable \$150 application fee. All first-year students are expected to reside on campus or submit an exemption request. The website provides extensive information about housing programs and services and includes floor plans for most student rooms.

Students living on campus are required to sign a full academic-year agreement. Releases from the agreement are granted on a caseby-case basis and may involve a financial penalty.
