Introduces students to the context and foundational knowledge required for managerial or administrative work within a healthcare system, physician practice, advocacy organizations, professional organizations, community health, and health care consulting. Students will examine the current state of health care in the United States with emphasis on leadership, performance improvement, and health care politics and policy. This minor is not intended for students with a major in Health Administration with a concentration in Health Systems Management as many of the required classes will overlap with the minor course work.

Students must complete all coursework with a minimum GPA of 2.00.
